World Skate Europe is proud to announce the Scooterling Park and Street European Championships to be held in Tjelta, Norway. The European Championships will take place 8th - 14th September 2025.

We will be hosting Men's, Women's and Junior competitions in each discipline.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Park Qualification, Semi-Final and Final rounds:

2x 45 second runs

Best run counts

Max score 100

Top 30 Men progress to the Semi-final

Top 10 Men, Women and Juniors progress to the Final

Street Qualification and Semi-Final rounds:

2x 45-second runs

Best run counts

Max score 100

Top 30 Men progress to the Semi-final

Top 10 Men, Women and Juniors progress to the Final

Street Final rounds:

2/3/3 format

2x 45-second runs followed by 3 single trick attempts

Runs scored out of 100, tricks scored out of 50 each. Total score combines the best run score with the two best single trick scores. Max score 200

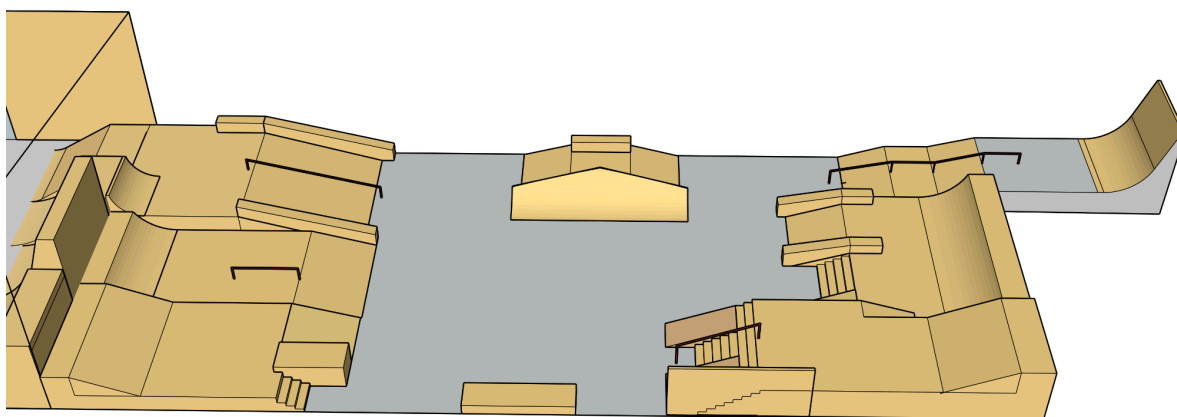

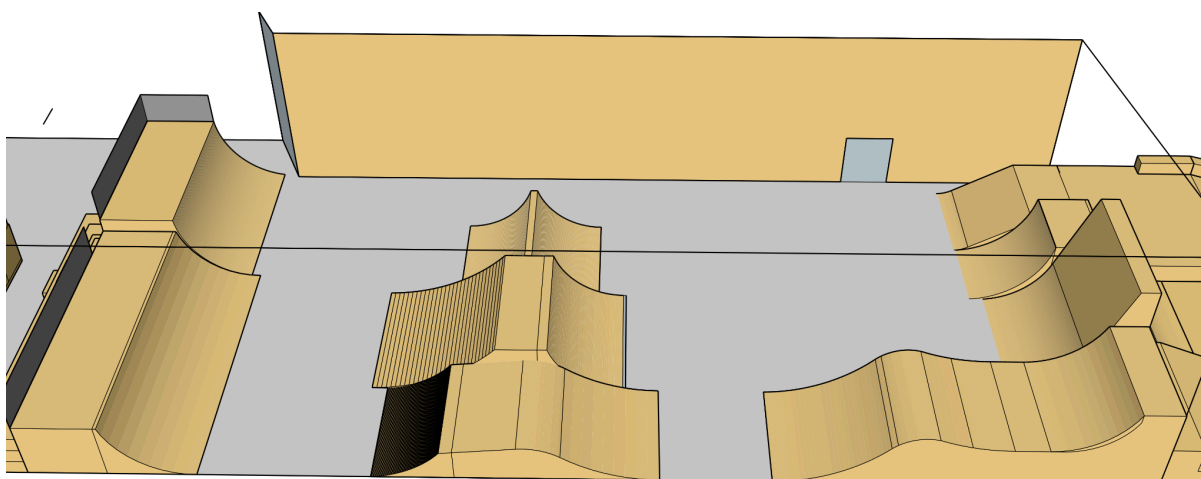
VENUE LOCATIONS & FIELDS OF PLAY

ATHLETE SAFETY (RULEBOOK 2025)

We remind all participating athletes that physical safety during practice and competition times is paramount. It is recommended that athletes of all ages and disciplines regularly review their protective equipment.

In Park, helmets are compulsory at all times during practice sessions and competitions for all athletes.

In Street, helmets are compulsory at all times during practice sessions and competitions for athletes 17 years of age or younger. We strongly encourage athletes to wear a helmet even if not mandatory.

Athletes found to be in violation of safety rules may be penalized with any of the following: reduction of practice time, disqualification from the current competition, or deduction of Ranking points.

The [Rulebook](#) includes more detailed technical details regarding entry requirements, pre-seeding information, safety equipment, area access, competition formats, practice limitations, judging clarification and much more.

We strongly recommend that all athletes, staff, coaches and other interests familiarize themselves with its contents.

RULES: World Skate rules will be applied.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Europe registration form. The form has been sent to all national federations and you can also download it here [DOWNLOAD](#).

National federation will collect all the riders to the same form and send it to European Technical Commission chairman Helmeri Pirinen for approval [Helmeri Pirinen](#) . After approval the invoice will follow.

WILD CARDS

Wild card athlete can send an individual application to Helmeri Pirinen for approval [Helmeri Pirinen](#) . Use the same form for individual application [DOWNLOAD](#). After approval the invoice will follow.

“Wild card athletes are athletes who are otherwise non-eligible to participate in the event but allowed to compete by World Skate. The status of a wild card athlete is granted at World Skate’s discretion and is limited to the following case:

- Lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete’s origin.”

REGISTRATION DATES:

May 1st - July 31th 2025

Applications received after July 31th 2025 will not be valid.

Junior: 80 EUR per discipline
